## Film Department Summer Assignment

**Description:** Find **10 video clips (as YouTube links)** that you feel exhibit strong filmmaking, and speak to you personally, **and explain why**. The video clips should be from a professional film or TV show. The strength of the film clip can relate to its cinematography, shot variety, editing, dramatic writing, etc.

**Requirements:**

1. **No more than two clips can be from the same film or TV episode.** We're looking for variety.
2. All ten YouTube links should be included in a ***single* PDF document**
3. Each link should include
  - **the name of the film or TV show** that the link is taken from.
  - **the time code (section of the clip)** that you are focusing on, for example 1:10 to 1:35.
  - **two or three sentences about what *YOU* think is strong about the film clip you selected and *WHY* it speaks to you.**
4. You will upload your Summer Assignment to the Google Classroom Summer Assignment in the first week of film class.

Your assignment is to read the entire book, and then select two essays from his book and answer the following questions for each essay. Make sure you write the essay at the top and then cut and paste these questions and then put the answers underneath them.

***What was the title of the piece?***

***How was it funny to you? or not?***

***Give me at least 3 examples of humor in each essay and explain to me WHY they were humorous.***

***What did reading this teach you about how comedy is used?***
