

## **Film Department Summer Assignment**

**(For rising freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors)**

**Description:** Find **10 video clips (as YouTube links)** that you feel exhibit strong filmmaking, and speak to you personally, **and explain why.** The video clips should be from a professional film or TV show. The strength of the film clip can relate to its cinematography, shot variety, editing, dramatic writing, etc.

### **Requirements:**

1. No more than two clips can be from the same film or TV episode. We're looking for variety.
2. All ten YouTube links should be included in a single PDF and uploaded to the Google Classroom Summer Assignment.
3. Each link should include
  - the name of the film or TV show that the link is taken from.
  - the time code (section of the clip) that you are focusing on, for example 1:10 to 1:35.
  - two or three sentences about **what you think is strong about the film clip you selected and why it speaks to you.**
