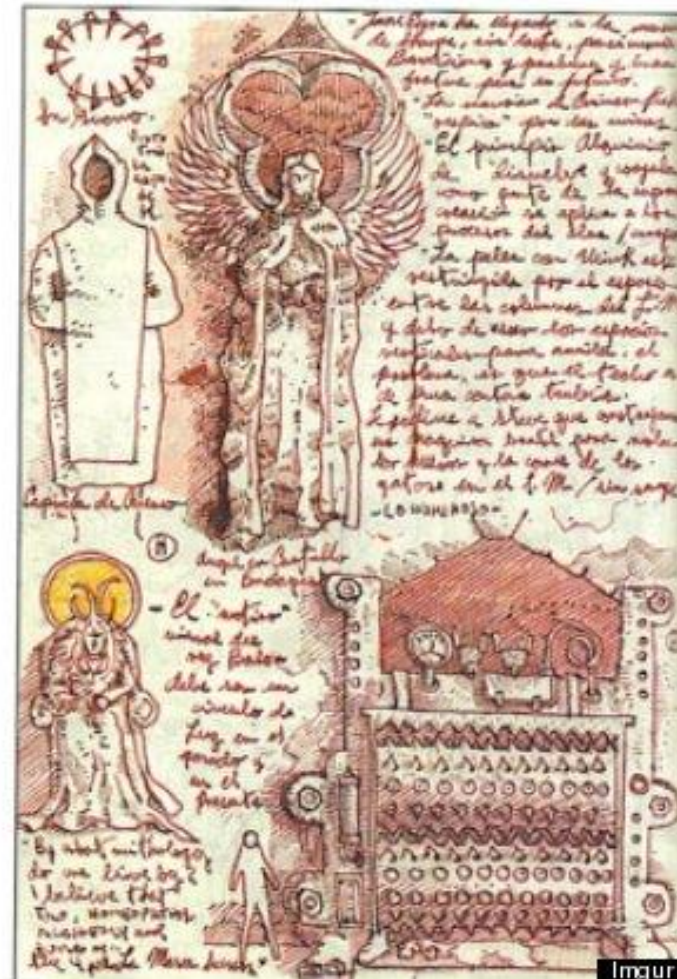
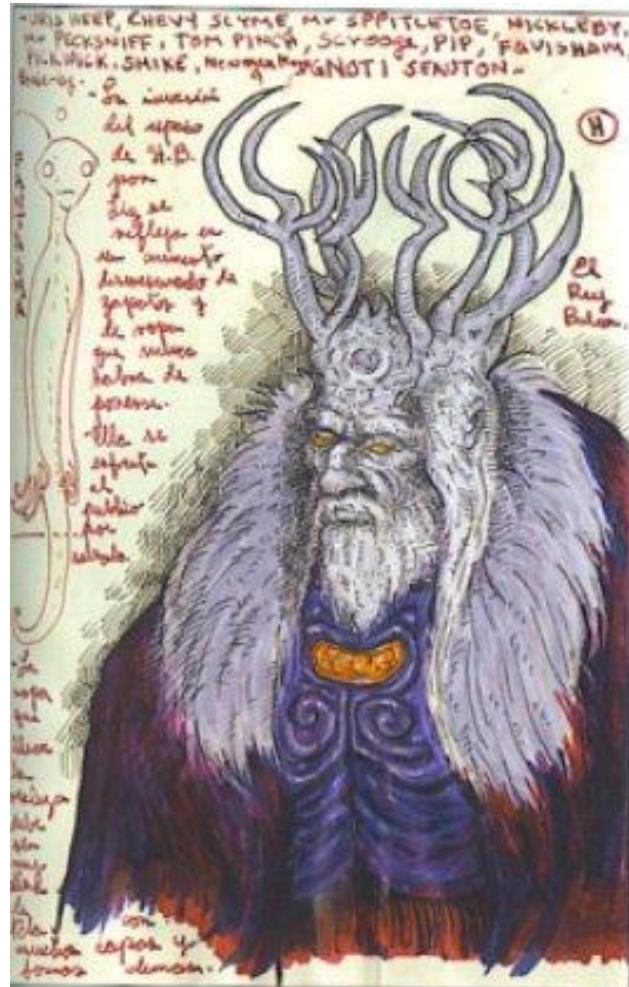

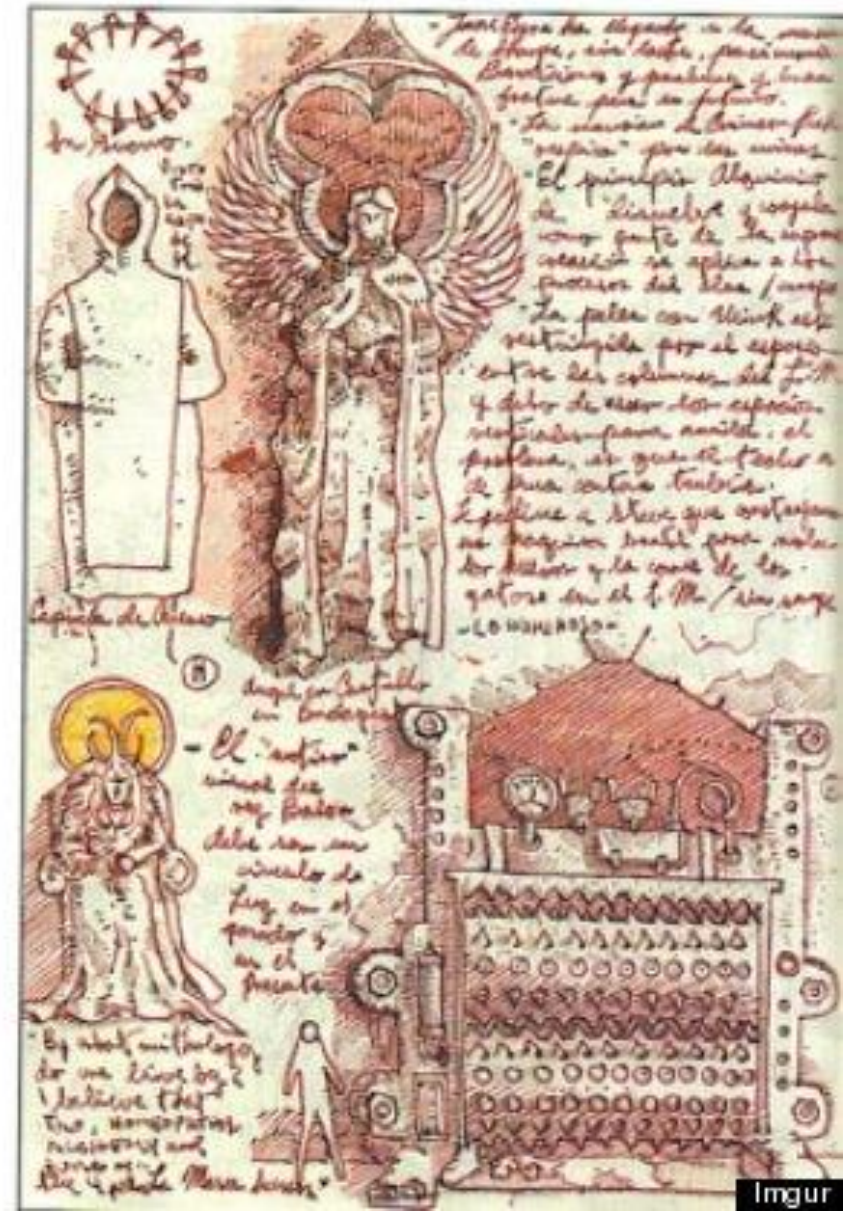
Guillermo Del Toro:

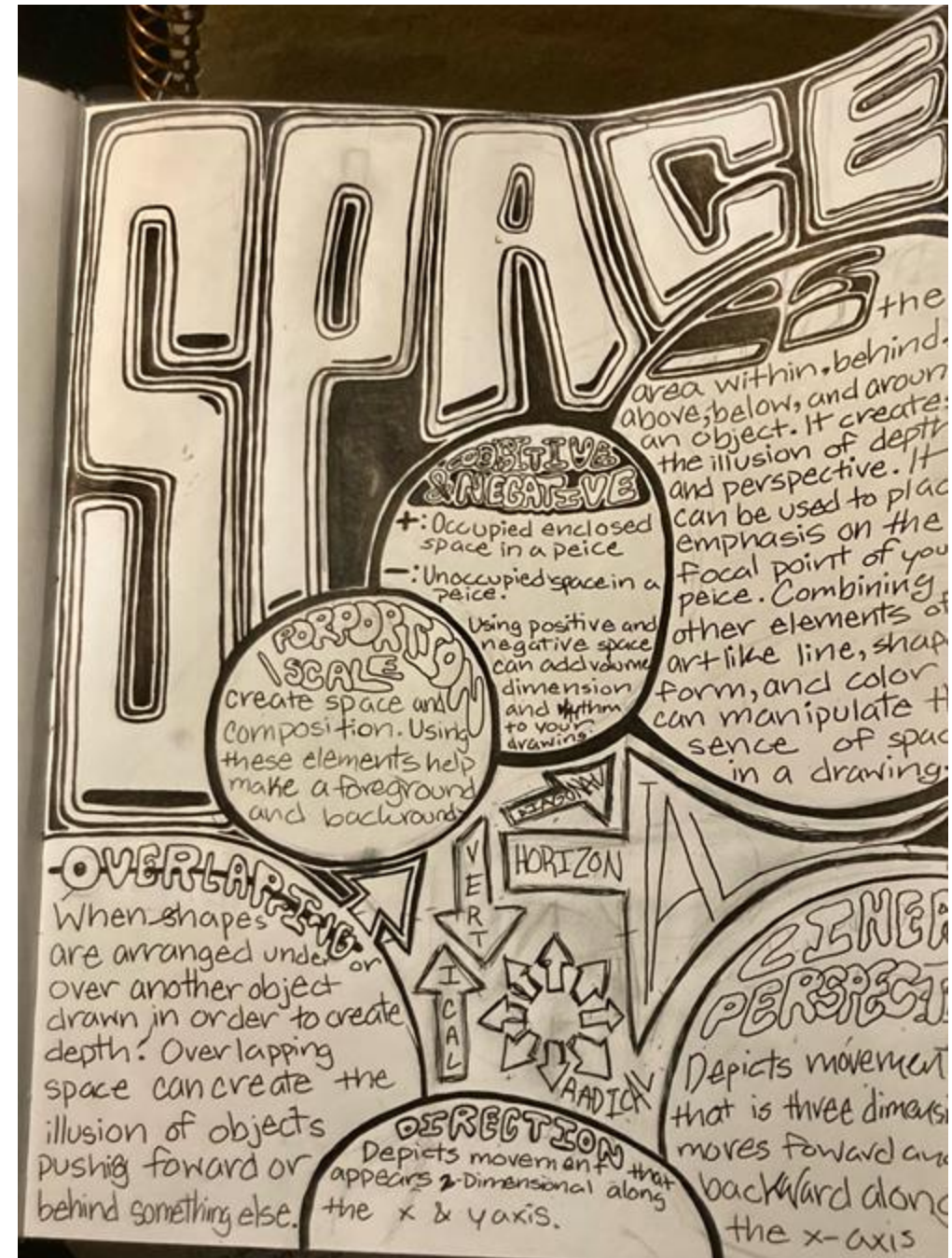
SUMMER HOMEWORK: **EXPLAINED**

(Written Information)

Notice how students are utilizing the space to create emphasis on the title and related vocabulary words defining each. All relevant information gathered from research and organized as it relates to the Element of Art being defined...

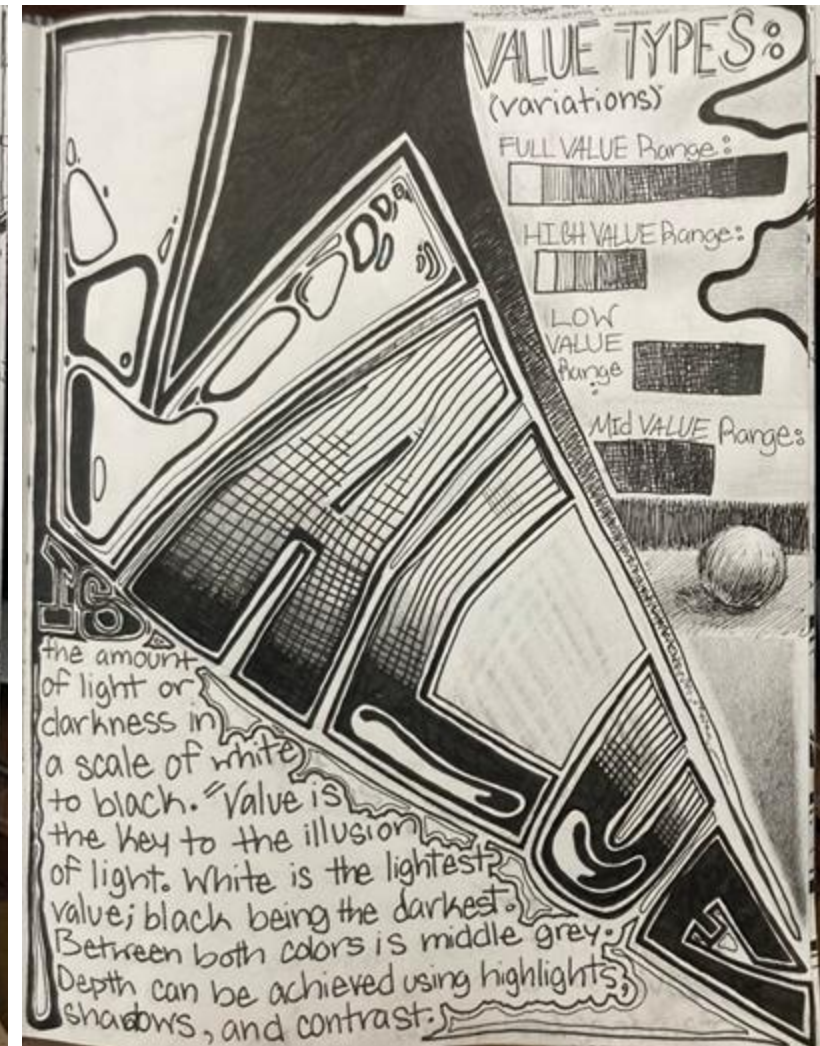
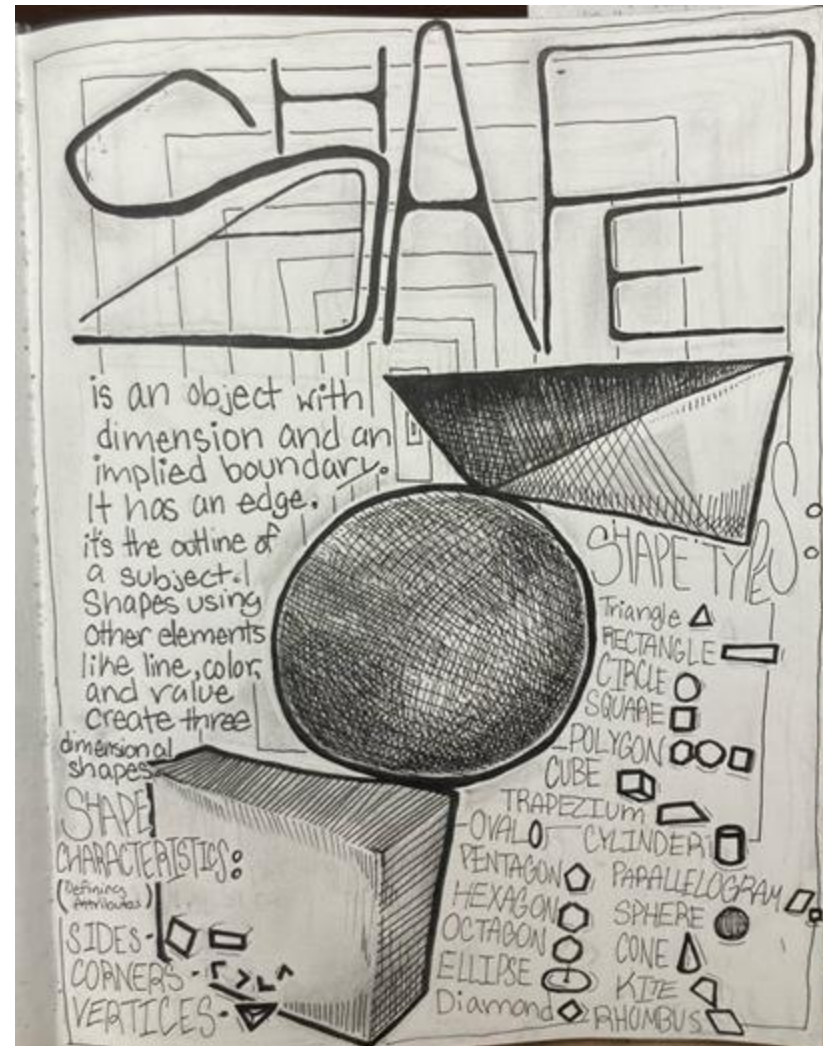
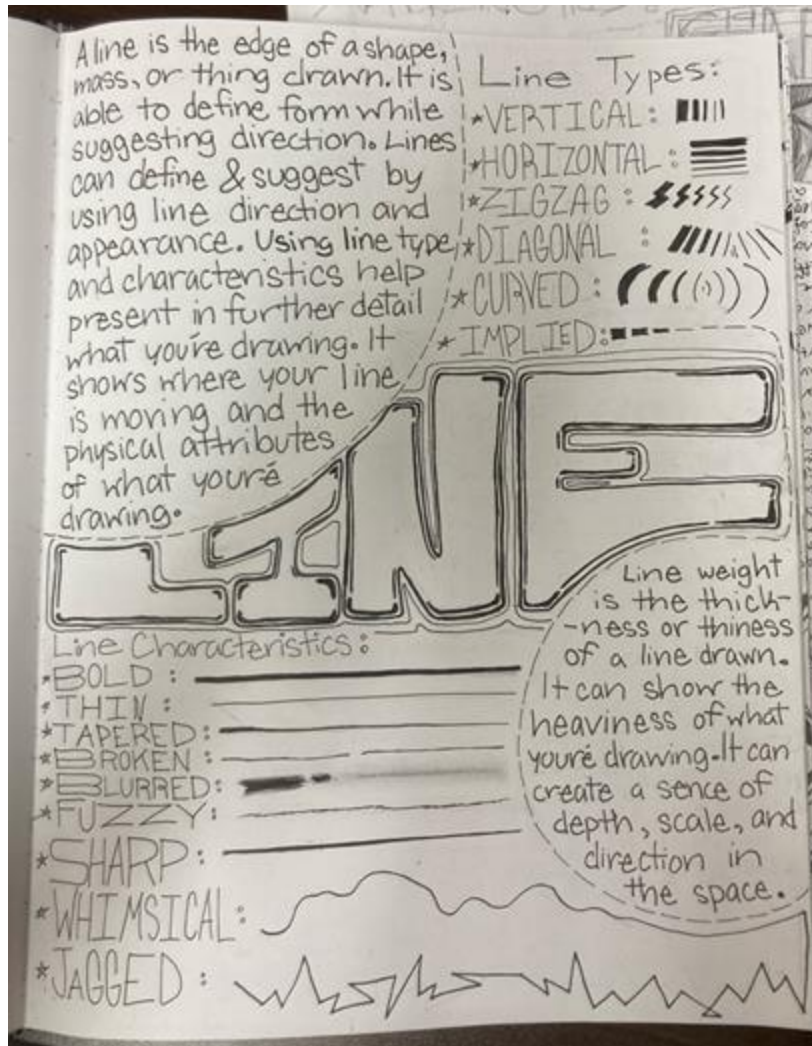
(Imagery)

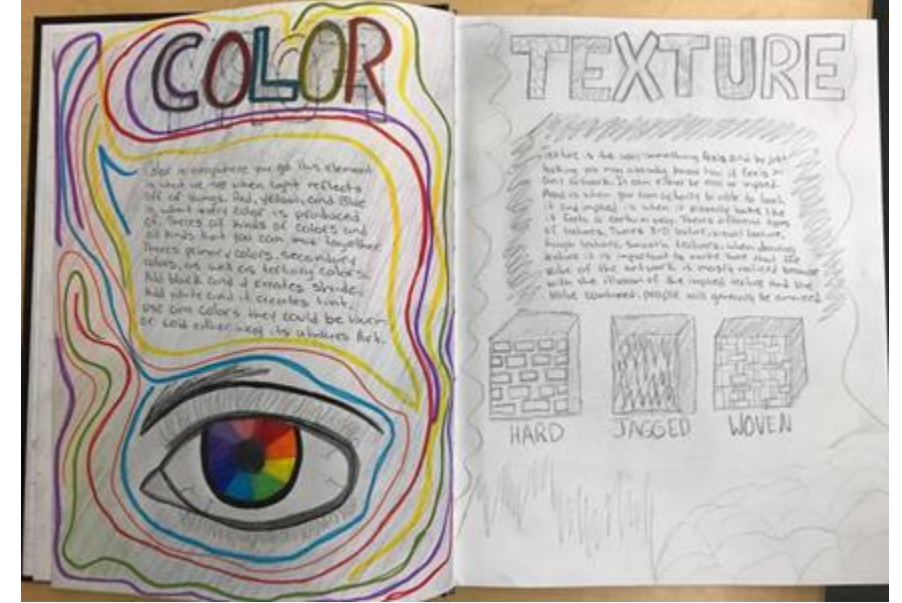
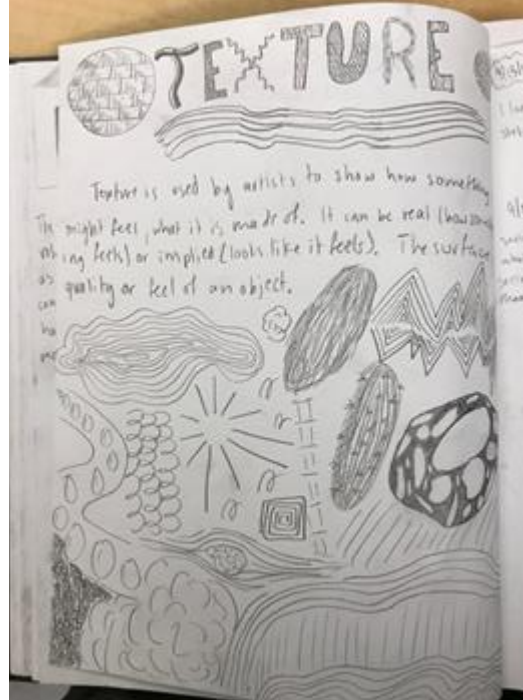
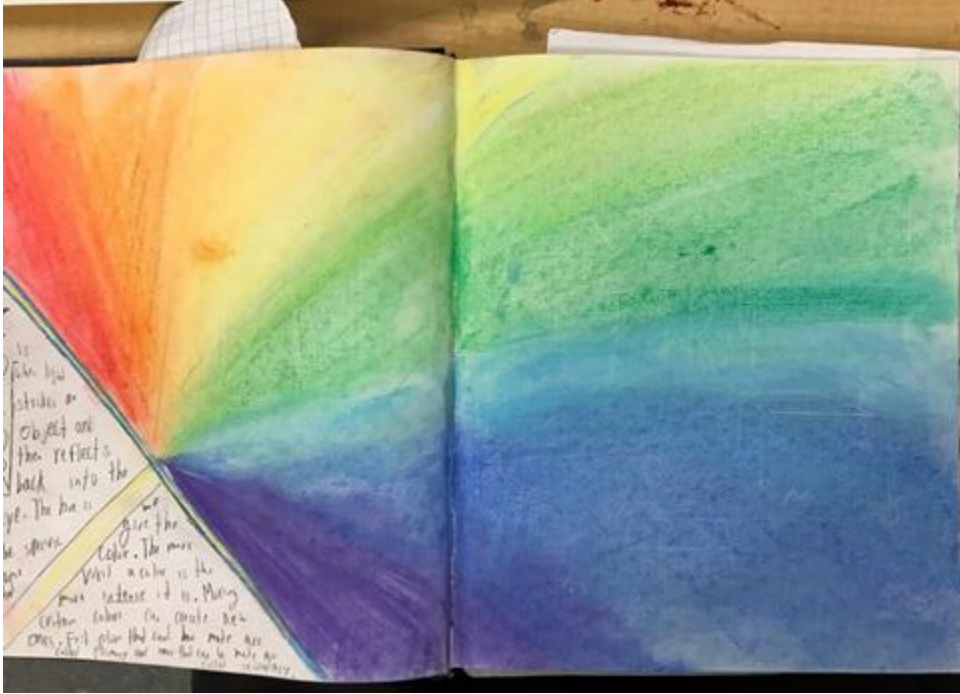
SUMMER HOMEWORK EXAMPLES: PRINCIPLES OF DESIGN



While the 7 Elements of Art must be defined on separate pages, You may define and illustrate all 7 Principles of Design on a 2-page spread.



SUMMER HOMEWORK: **PITFALLS TO AVOID**



Examples of Student Artwork

(Imagery) Notice how some students write little, putting more effort into the imagery... try to establish a balance between words and imagery.

(Page Layout) Notice how the student's work on the right, at the bottom is blank but tries to fill it with drawings not related to the title... You want to fill the space in every page you design with relevant drawings and information!

SUMMER HOMEWORK INSTRUCTIONS: Further Explanation

Each Page Must Contain the Following Information:

Title Block

(Name of the Element or Principle)

Sub-Titles

(These are important vocabulary words related to the Element being defined. In regards to the HW#3, each Principle should be treated as a sub-title as observed in this student's example...)

Definition (Written)

(Take notes as you research! You're expected to write down your "findings" and prepare a well written paragraph, providing a definition, using relevant vocabulary words.)

Demonstration (Illustrated)

(Consider the whole page, or a partial page design. Notice how the eye is a color wheel! What can you design and/or draw to illustrate the meaning of the Element or Principle being defined.)
