Observational drawing  
Drawings should be done on drawing paper of 8x10 - 9x12  
Black and white media: Graphite, pastels, conté crayon.  
**NOT DIGITAL**

**Be prepared to submit your work the first week of school.**

1. Figure drawing - use these websites for figure drawing - bodiesinmotion.photo, line-of-action.com - or better yet, have someone pose for you in person!

Draw at least 20 different figure drawings using (2 minutes each) using the simple shapes to draw through

2. Assemble 3-5 items with different heights, textures and forms. Apply a direct light source. Draw and render the still life items and the table it is upon. Apply the full range of tones to your drawings. Smoothly transition from one tone to another using traditional pencil rendering.

3. Draw a self portrait from the shoulders up, focusing on the face. Render your portrait in a cartoon style of your choice. This can be your personal cartooning style, or a style from your favorite cartoon media.

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### **RISING JUNIORS**

#### **Cast of Characters Line-Up:**

Review the list of character archetypes below. Draw a character lineup using 8-10 individual original characters based on the archetypes from the list. Think of how you can use the principles of stretch and squash to vary their height, shapes and poses. The original characters should be in a similar style throughout. Use your reference online or your own reference to pose your figures as needed.

The project can be completed traditionally or digitally.  
Look at the examples at the end.


#### **Requirements:**

- Pose each character using balance, weight and a dynamic line of action based on their role and personality in your story.
- The line-up should be rendered in either black and white ink or finished in full color.
- They should all be standing on the same plane (as if it was a police lineup)
- The characters should fit onto 8.5 by 11" Bristol paper (landscape). (can use multiple sheets if need be)
- Must use at least 7 different archetypes.
- Must include a hero and villain.
- Write a brief story synopsis (100 words or less) about your cast of characters.

### **Four-Panel Comics (webcomic style)**

Make a four-panel (or more) comic once a week for the entire summer (starting the week of July 1<sup>st</sup>). See the next page for samples, size, measuring.

Requirements:

- 8 comics at least (can be more!)
- It can be autobiographical, semi-autobiographical or based on the adventures of your own characters.
- You can create your comics digitally or traditionally.
- You can finish them rendered in black and white or color.
- Keep your gutters and overall size of each comic consistent throughout each piece. (This doesn't mean you can't change the size of your panels if you need to but make sure each comic is the same size so it can be collected potentially in a zine or book.)

If working digitally, use a square 8x8 inch canvas for webcomic style and 10x15 inch canvas for a traditional comic book style orientation. Make sure your work is 300 DPI or more.

### **Comic Con Try-Outs (Optional)**

Comic Con is the second week of October so we need to start preparing over the summer. Think fan art and pieces that will be popular around the time of the con.

Have the following ready when we come back to school (We only need the designs)
